LOGAN HIGH VISUAL ART SCHOLAR AWARD FOR GRADUATING SENIORS

A visual art scholar award may be earned by accumulating a total of 30 points in any of the following ways:

- 1. Semester grade of A- or higher in any basic visual art class. (3 points per semester)
- 2. Semester grade of A- or higher in any advanced visual art class. (5 points per semester)
- 3. One or more pieces entered in any regional, statewide or national contest. (3 points for entering, 5 points for being juried in)
- **4.** Placing 1st, 2nd, 3rd or Honorable Mention in a statewide, national or regional contest.

- 5. Placing 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the LHS Fine Arts Fair. (5 pts for 1st, 3 pts for 2nd, 1 pt for 3rd)
- **6.** Pass the Advanced Placement Visual Arts exam. (20 points)
- 7. Complete the AP Art requirements. (10 points)
- **8.** Selected as Sterling Scholar in Visual Art for Logan High School. (20 points)
- **9.** Assemble and display a one person visual art show. (20 points)
- **10.** Working for a business doing visual art work. (3 points per semester)

Candidates must submit a letter of application to any art department faculty itemizing their qualifications and requesting consideration for the visual art scholar award.
